



Registrations to Activities School-aged Children - High School Winter 2021

Trait d'Union has examined its offer of services for the Winter taking into consideration current circumstances. In this document, you will find services provided by the organisation as well as all information required to register your child.

For whom?

These services are provided to teenagers attending high school. Their family must also be members of Trait d'Union.

When?

The "Winter 2021" session begins the week of January 25 and ends on March 28, 2021.

When and how to register?

Please note that the number of places is limited, therefore it's important that you register your child during the registration period to access the activities.

Registration will take place from November 23 to 29, 2020. To register your child, you must complete the form available on our web site (www.traitudunionoutaouais.com).

The form will be available as of November 23 at 6 p.m.

Persons who do not have access to the Internet or who are less familiar with these technologies can **make an appointment** during the registration period and fill out their form at TUOI's offices with the help of one of our employees.

Activities offered to teenagers with an Aspie profile

*Please note that you will need to communicate your preference between the two services (virtual or in person) on the registration form and that, based on the number of registrations received, the participant may only be able to register to one activity.

Virtual group Game

- The group meets virtually every week. Educator's facilitate discussions and games.
- **Thursday evenings** from 6 to 7 :30 p.m.
- Free

In-person group leisure activities at Trait d'Union

- An opportunity to see friends
- Games will be proposed to groups
- Recreational walks in the organisation's neighborhood or activities near Trait d'Union can be organized based on participants' interests
- To respect social distancing, a maximum of four people per group will be allowed. Spots will therefore be split among registrations received.
- Every **Saturdays** from 1:30 to 4:30 p.m. at TUOI, 109 Wright St. (Hull sector)
- Free activity

Group activities (teenagers with an autism profile)

- Based on the level of coaching and support needed per participant, a maximum of three participants per group is allowed.
- Fun activities will be proposed, in TUOI facility, based on interests expressed by participants.
- Given that it's impossible to travel by car with participants, no community outings will be offered. Nearby outdoor activities could however be added to the programming based on participants' interests and on the weather (walks, library, etc.).
- Every **Saturdays**
- 2 options available:
 - o 9 a.m. to noon at TUOI's, 109 Wright St. (Hull sector)
 - o 1 :30 to 4 :30 p.m. at 200 Robert Wright St. (Aylmer sector)

*Please note that you must indicate your preference between the two time blocks available on the registration form, but the team reserves the right to assign participants to the time block the most appropriate for the participants to maximise cohesion and coherence among groups, based on participants' profiles and interests.

Financial assistance

A special fund of \$ 30,000 is available at TUOI to provide financial assistance to families who wish to purchase services outside of TUOI's offering. An amount up to 500\$ per family can be authorized for the period included between September 1st 2020 and March 28th 2021.

The allowance can be used to purchase services or hire self-employed workers to provide childcare at home or have access to rest care services.

Assigning spots

Assigning spots will be done based on our spot management policy (available on our web site). We will assign spots among all registrants, in a fair manner, based on the demand and the level of support and coaching required for each individual.

Activities will be prioritized based on people who will complete the form within the allocated time.

REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE REGISTRATION PERIOD.

Process follow-up

After the registration period, the coordination team will meet to create groups in a manner that respects age groups and participants' needs while maximizing the service offer.

Parents will receive confirmation of dates provided, via the contract and by mail, before December 13, 2020.
