#### Programming

Trait d'Union Outaouais offers weekly activity programming for groups that takes place from Tuesday to Saturday. Activities aim to stimulate personal development, autonomy within the community, social and professional skills as well as leisure activities.

#### For whom?

- Persons aged 21 and up who no longer attend school as well as adults from 18 to 20 who attend a post-secondary school.
- Persons who wish to take part in activities must be members of TUOI and must have renewed their membership for the current year.

#### When?

The "Spring 2021" session begins the week of March 29 and ends on June 6, 2021.

#### When and how to register?

- Registration will take place from February 8 to 14, 2021.

## Details of Activities Presented

### Socio-professional Development and Autonomy Component

<p><b>Micro-enterprise « Opération Snack »</b></p> <p><b>Fridays from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.</b></p>	<p><i>Open to all</i></p> <p>The micro-enterprise is a small culinary business. Participants are involved in all steps of the process. They plan the menu for the week and buy the food, prepare it and sell it.</p> <p>Also, the micro-enterprise team establishes prices, do the promotion and the accounting. Compensation (symbolic amount) will be given to participants every two weeks.</p> <p>The activity allows participants to develop a work routine and acquire several socio-professional skills, such as organisation, initiative, relationships with others, etc.</p> <p>During the fall, we are redirecting the business towards the sale of meals for other Trait d'Union services. An educator from Trait d'Union accompanies participants in their learning and proposes challenges to help them learn and progress.</p> <p>We're currently trying to find an environment where participants can volunteer. <b>Social Club – Recreational activities*</b> <b>Thursday</b> from 6 to 9 p.m.	<b>Virtual discussion and game group</b> <b>Friday</b> from 6:30 to 8 p.m.
<p>Since leisure activities are currently restricted, we are offering an evening of discussions, games, video games at Trait d'Union. An educator will facilitate activities throughout the evening.</p> <p>Participants will share a meal with friends that can be a pot-luck, a meal served by our micro-enterprise or take-out from a restaurant.</p> <p>We will need to respect hygiene measures and social distancing rules. For this reason, we will only be able to welcome a limited number of participants.</p>	<p>These evenings are an opportunity for Asperger adults to share and discuss life experiences or simply chat with other people in a similar situation.</p> <p>A field worker from Trait d'Union will be hosting the virtual group to facilitate exchanges, answer questions and help you with some of your endeavours.</p>

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## Other

<p><b>Drop in</b></p> <p><b>Tuesday and Wednesday</b> from 1 to 4 p.m.</p>	<p>Drop-in offer free-style programming where participants can explore various activities using materials available at TUOI. They may also bring materials from home to work on personal projects. This informal environment allows for meetings and exchanges among participants, as well as the option to discuss with educators on their individual needs to find means and resources to meet these needs.</p> <p>Participant must be able to follow the hygiene protocols and social distancing, a limited number of participants will be allowed on the premises at the same time</p>	<p><b>Address:</b> 109 Wright Street, Gatineau</p> <p><b>Free activity</b></p> <p><b>Dates:</b> March 29 and ends on June 6, 2021</p>
<p><b><u>Particularities</u></b></p> <p><b>Tuesday:</b> <i>Participants must be able to meet their own basic needs and keep busy on their own. A single field worker is on site with participants.</i></p> <p><b>Wednesday:</b> <i>A second field worker will be present during drop-ins to coach and guide participants requiring more support so that they can benefit from their time at Trait d'Union, outside their normal life environment. The educator will be able to suggest various activities, accompany participants in achieving personal autonomy and developing, if possible, varied interests. Participants must still be able to keep busy on their own during the activity.</i></p>		

## For natural families

### **Financial assistance**

A special fund is available at TUOI to provide financial assistance to families who wish to purchase services outside of TUOI's offering. An amount up to 500\$ per family can be authorized for the period included between April 1<sup>st</sup> 2021 and August 31<sup>st</sup> 2021.

The allowance can be used to purchase services or hire self-employed workers to provide childcare at home or have access to respite services.
