



TUOI SUMMER CAMP 2021 - REGISTRATION

Offer of services:

Specialized summer camp for autistic persons aged 5 to 21.

Participants are grouped based on their age, level of development and support needs. The program's goal is the social integration and development of autonomy and social skills using a structured program adapted to participants' needs.

When?

The camp will be held between July 5 and August 12, 2021.

Camps will take place from Monday to Thursday, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

A mandatory information meeting for initial contact with educators will be held sometime in mid-June (information to come).

Where will the day camp be held?

The camp will take place in the rooms of the Cégep de l'Outaouais, Gabrielle Roy campus in the Hull sector.

Who can register?

These activities are targeted for children aged **5 and over** who have completed **one full year in a school environment** and whose family has renewed its **membership** to the organisation for the current year.

How much does it cost?

The camp costs \$120 a week (equals \$30 a day).

A full-week registration (4 consecutive days from Monday to Thursday) is now **mandatory**.

Once you will have received the registration contract and the invoice, you will need to pay the registration fees in two installments. The first instalment will need to be paid during the initial mandatory meeting in June, at the latest, and the second instalment will need to be paid mid-way through the camp. These fees are payable by cheque, by debit, by credit card or by cash (details will be provided on the invoice).

The cancellation and refund policy is available upon request.

How can I register?

The registration period will be held from April 12 to 18, 2021.

To register your child, fill out the form available on our web site (www.traidunionoutaouais.com).

The form will be available as of April 12 at 6 p.m.

Those of you who do not have access to Internet or who are less familiar with these technologies can make an appointment during the registration period to complete the registration form with the support of one of our employees. REMINDER: A weekly registration (4 consecutive days, from Monday to Thursday) is now mandatory.

Teenagers aged 15 and over:
Programming for "Aspi" teenagers will be amalgamated to that of the adult sector, like in previous years. In April, families will receive complementary information on programming options, as well as related costs and procedures.

How will places be assigned?

The internal procedure to assign places will be applied based on the number of requests received.

- A maximum of 3 weeks of camp will be applied to the first round of place assignments based on requests received.
- During a second round, weeks may be added based on availability and specific prioritization criteria (date and time of forms received, continuity of services, limited access to other camps, natural family, etc.).

***This procedure is subject to change based on health measures in effect.

What happens once I've registered to day camp?

Within 30 business days after the registration date, TUOI will send, by mail, to parents or tutors, a registration contract confirming the registration weeks.

The parent will need to return the signed contract to the organisation by June 11, 2021.

Mid-June, one of the parents or tutors will need to take part in the information session and the participant will need be present for an initial meeting with the educational team. Details to come.
