



Registrations to Activities School-aged Teens Fall 2021

Trait d'Union has examined its offer of services for the fall, taking into consideration current circumstances. In this document, you will find services provided by the organisation as well as all information required to register your child.

For whom?

These services are provided to teens. Please refer to each service's description to know the specific age group. The family must also have renewed their membership for the current year.

When?

The Fall 2021 session begins the week of September 20th and ends on December 19th, 2021.

When and how to register?

Please note that the number of spaces are limited; therefore it is important that you register your child during the registration period to access the activities.

Registration will take place from August 16th to 22nd, 2021. To register your child, you must complete the form available on our web site (www.traitudunionoutaouais.com).

The form will be available as of August 16 at 6 p.m.

Persons who do not have access to the Internet or who are less familiar with technology can **make an appointment** during the registration period and fill out their form at TUOI's offices with the help of one of our employees.

Please leave a message at 819-595-1290, ext. 23 **before August 13th, 2021**, and a member of our team will contact you to make an appointment to help you fill out the form during the registration period.

Day Time Respite

Respite service with a less structured program. Lots of free time and leisure activities offer at the location. Fun activities will be proposed, based on interests expressed by participants. Nearby outdoor activities could be added to the programming based on participants' interests and on the weather (walks, library, etc.).

Overnight Respite (14 and over)

- Educators will offer activities aimed toward community living (meal prep, cleaning, personal hygiene...) with free time and a bit less structured activity.
- For people with autism over the age of 14, all profile, living in **their natural family**.
- Once a month, from Friday evening to Sunday afternoon.
- Prior to participation, families must be available to fill out an extensive questionnaire to help our team to assess participants' need.
- At 200 Robert-Wright (Aylmer sector)
- \$100 per weekend
- Dates:

 - ⇒ November 12-13-14
 - ⇒ December 10-11-12

ASPERGERS PROGRAMME / AUTISM WITHOUT COGNITIVE IMPAIRMENT (TEENS)

- Mixed programming (face-to-face and virtual), oriented towards socialization and self-awareness.
- For adolescents attending high school with an Asperger's / no cognitive impairment profile, verbal, able to function in a ratio of 1: 4
- The participant can choose to participate in one or both of the activities. It will be important to indicate this in the registration form.

In person – Socialization group

- From 10 to 4 pm, 1 Saturday per month

- Cost : \$30 per day

Virtual group with games

- The group meets virtually every week. Facilitators will lead discussions and games.
- Wednesdays evenings from 6 to 7 :30 p.m. from September 22 to December 15, 2021
- Free

Assigning Spaces

Spaces will be assigned based on our space management policy (available on our web site).

We will assign spaces among all registrants, in a fair manner, based on the demand and the level of support and coaching required for each individual.

Activities will be prioritized based on people who will complete the form within the allocated time.

REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE REGISTRATION PERIOD.

Process follow-up

After the registration period, the coordination team will meet to create groups in a manner that respects age groups and participants' needs while maximizing the service offer.

Parents will receive confirmation of dates provided, via the contract and by mail, before September 16th, 2021.
