



TUOI SUMMER CAMP 2023 - REGISTRATION

Offer of services:

Specialized summer camp for autistic participants aged 5 to 21.

Participants are grouped based on their age, level of development and support needs. The program's goal is the social integration and development of autonomy and social skills using a structured program adapted to participants' needs.

When?

The camp will be held between July 3 and August 10, 2023.

Camps will take place from Monday to Thursday, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. (no childcare service before and after camp regular hours)

A mandatory information meeting for initial contact with educators will be held sometime in mid-June (information to come with the contract).

Where will the day camp be held?

The camp site has yet to be confirmed.

Who can register?

These activities are targeted for children **aged 5 (who have completed one full year in a full-time school Environment)** to 21, and whose family has renewed its membership to the organization for the current year (2023-2024 to be renewed in May 2023).

How much does it cost?

The camp costs \$120 a week (equals \$30 a day).

A full-week registration (4 consecutive days from Monday to Thursday) is now mandatory.

Once you receive the registration contract and the invoice, you will need to pay the registration fees in two instalments. The first instalment will need to be paid during the initial mandatory meeting in June, at the latest, and the second instalment will need to be paid midway through the camp. These fees are payable by cheque, by Interact transfer, by credit card or by cash (details will be provided on the invoice).

The cancellation and refund policy are available upon request

How to register?

The registration period will be held from April 3rd to 9th, 2023.

To register your child, fill out the form available on our web site (www.traidunionoutaouais.com).

The form will be available as of April 3rd at 6 p.m.

Those of you who do not have access to the Internet or who are less familiar with these technologies can **make an appointment** during the registration period to complete the registration form with the support of one of our employees. How will places be assigned?

Following last year's situation, the procedure for allocating places is currently under review and will be communicated after being adopted at the next meeting of the Board of Directors (March 23rd).

What happens once I've registered?

Within 30 business days after the registration date, TUOI will send, by mail, to parents or tutors, a registration contract confirming the registration weeks.

The parent will need to return the signed contract to the organization by June 10, 2023.

Mid-June, parents or tutors will need to take part in the information session and the participant will need to be present for an initial meeting with the educational team. Details to come.
